CLIENT-FACING

Volunteers in these roles work directly with clients inside our medical clinics.

Client Advocate

Client Advocates provide compassionate, life-affirming support for clients for visit for pregnancy or STI testing.

Advocates create a safe, respectful place where clients can be heard, receive accurate information for their health and safety, and feel supported as they navigate their next steps.

This role can be filled by men or women.

Breathe Leader

Our BREATHE program fosters safe environments where people can heal after an abortion.

Volunteers have a range of opportunities to serve including one-to-one conversations or small group sessions.

At this time, BREATHE is offered exclusively to female clients; however, by adding male volunteers, we hope to expand the program to serve men as well.

Medical Staff

Medical volunteers assist with pregnancy testing, STI testing, limited obstetric ultrasounds, health and pregnancy education, and referrals.

Working alongside center staff, medical volunteers support maternal and infant health by offering accurate information and helping clients feel cared for, informed, and supported.



CLIENT-FACING

Volunteers in these roles work directly with clients inside our medical clinics.

Wellness Class Leader

Wellness Class educators help facilitate Wellness Journey classes such as Birth Mapping, Infant Care, Breastfeeding, and Childbirth. These volunteers build an encouraging learning environment where clients can ask questions, build confidence, and gain practical skills..

REQUIREMENTS

Training for those working directly with our clients is required and will be provided. You'll be required to read + sign the Volunteer Manual as well as our Mission and Statements, complete an application form, enroll in our Background Check, and complete the training as a Mandatory Reporter. OSHA training will also be provided. Medical volunteers will submit current licenses/certificates.



EVENTS & OUTREACH

Campus Outreach

Campus Outreach Volunteers help increase awareness of the pregnancy center's services by distributing flyers and outreach materials so students know what services are available and how to schedule an appointment if they or someone they know needs support.

Events & Hospitality

Events & Hospitality Volunteers help create welcoming, well-organized experiences for guests at events that Network of Life hosts. Responsibilities may include brainstorming and pre-event planning, and helping with hospitality needs to ensure events run smoothly. Event examples include but are not limited to: Annual Fundraising Banquet, Client Mother's Day Brunch, Client Christmas Party.

You'll be required to read + sign the Volunteer Manual as well as our Mission and Statements, complete an application form, and enroll in our Background Check.



CHURCH ENGAGEMENT

Church Ambassador

Church Ambassadors serve as a key connection between their church and Network of Life by helping coordinate baby bottle campaigns, sharing ministry updates and prayer requests, and educating their congregation about the free, life-affirming services we provide.

Baby Bottle Campaign

Baby Bottle Campaign Volunteers assist with preparing materials, counting donations, and helping with bottle distribution and pick-up at churches throughout the greater Pittsburgh area.

You'll be required to read + sign the Volunteer Manual as well as our Mission and Statements, complete an application form, and enroll in our Background Check.



ADMINISTRATIVE

Admin Volunteer

Admin Office Volunteers offer a flexible way to support the daily operations of Network of Life through practical, hands-on tasks. Tasks may include writing thank-you cards, assembling mailings, and organizing office inventory.

REQUIREMENTS

You'll be required to sign our Confidentiality agreement as well as our Mission and Statements, complete an application form, and enroll in our Background Check.



Volunteer Orientation

Volunteer Orientation is for anyone considering the many ways to volunteer at *Network of Life*. As you learn more about why we serve, who we serve, and how we serve, you'll be encouraged in your faith journey and strengthened in your pro-life stance.

This two-day experience allows you to explore our client services programs and ways to serve all aspects of the Network. You'll hear from members of our medical team, learn about the Wellness Journey, BREATHE After Abortion Care, Men's Programs, and more. Together, we welcome and engage moms and dads from the initial pregnancy appointment and ultrasound to adoption, parenting and beyond.
